

## **Verification of Identity Certificate**

Instructions for completing this form

- 1. This form is used for Verification of Identity conducted in Australia during a face-to-face interview or by Smart Verify.
- 2. A separate form is to be completed for each individual acting in the capacity of Borrower, Guarantor, Attorney under a Power of Attorney, or Identity Declarant.
- 3. The verifier can only be a Westpac Group staff member or a Westpac accredited Broker (for Broker-originated applications).
- 4. Current and original documents must be used for verification unless otherwise stated.
- 5. If any document is written in a language other than English, it must be accompanied by an English translation prepared by an accredited translator.
- 6. The verifier is to attach evidence of the Verification of Identity to this document as follows:
  - · Where verification was conducted by Smart Verify: a copy of the ID Verification Report.
  - Where verification was conducted by face-to-face interview: copies of the original identification documents provided.
  - Additionally, where a Westpac accredited Broker conducted verification by face-to-face interview, the Broker must
    certify the copies of the original identification documents by signing, dating, and endorsing the copies as true copies of
    the original document.
- 7. Where Section 2 is used the verifier must be reasonably satisfied that the photographic documents bear a reasonable likeness to the person being identified.
- 8. Sections 3 or 4 are only to be used where the verifier is reasonably satisfied that the documents required to complete Section 2 cannot be produced.
- 9. Place a tick [1] in the box beside the documents for which copies have been provided for Verification of Identity.
